Presentations

These will take place at **Karl-Rahner-Platz 3 (Jesuitenplatz), 6020 Innsbruck** in the so-called 'Leopoldssaal'. You can find the room on the second floor. The breaks will take place distributed over all 3 floors, with coffee and sacks being served on the ground floor.

Depending on your starting point, there are different ways to get there:

- You can get off from various buses and trams at station Museumstrasse (crossing of Sillgasse/Museumstrasse). Walk down Sillgasse, turn left, and you will be at the so-called Jesuiten-Platz. The entrance to Leopolds-Saal is on your left
- Assuming you come the old town ("Goldenes Dachl"), head to the east and walk down Universitätsstrasse. The Jesuitenplatz is quite visible and on your right. Entrance to the Leopoldssaal will be to your left when standing in front of the church.

Conference Dinner

We shall convene at the restaurant Bierstindl, Klostergasse 6, 6020 Innsbruck. It is located (more or less) within walking distance of the Leopoldssaal.

Depending on your starting point, there are different ways to get there:

- From Leopoldssaal, head towards Triumph-Pforte, via Wiltener-Platz, to Grassmeier-Kreuzung. Go on towards Stift Wilten (see map below) and you will end up directly at Bierstindl.
- Car: There are parking lots, but not too many, directly at the Bierstindl.



Open-Lab-Day at Technik

The research and development areas at the “Technik” will be available for you to visit, discuss, plan, collaborate, etc.

Depending on your starting point, there are different ways to get there:

- Take tram 2 or 5 towards the West, and get off the tram at ‘Technikerstrasse’.
- Look for the tallest building on the campus to the west, enter, and take the elevator to the 4th floor. A reception is available at the tea/coffee room to help you along depending on which labs you want to visit.
